This practice enables staff to confirm receipt of the motion, clarify wording with the mover, and publish the motion ahead of the meeting to support informed debate on the issue. To be considered at the meeting, motions must be submitted by 11:59 pm (CST) on Thursday, April 24, 2025, to Diana Cepe at dcepe@apegs.ca.

Movers will be provided with an opportunity to present a brief (2 minutes or less) introduction to the motion. Those in-person at the meeting will be able to present the motion in the meeting. Movers attending virtually may submit their introduction as an audio or video recording. Both the mover and the seconder must pre-register and attend the meeting for the motion to be presented and considered by members in attendance.
