L.(Eng) or P.L.(Geo))</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 6 years of experience, 2 years of experience within a Defined Scope of Practice and completed under the supervision and control of a Professional Member.</li> <li>• Requires the NPPE.</li> </ul>	<p><b>ASET Member Professional Technologist (P.Tech.(Eng.))</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 6 years of experience, 2 years under P.Eng./P.Geo.</li> <li>• C.E.T in good standing with ASET</li> <li>• Requires NPPE after January 2014 – APEGA contracted to deliver the exam for ASET.</li> </ul>	<p><b>ASET Members Registered Engineering Technologist (R.E.T.) 1985-2009 Certified Engineering Technologist (C.E.T) still in place</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 2 years of experience, 9 months as a tech. minimum and supervisory validation of 5 competency benchmarks</li> </ul> <p><b>NOTE – Inter-Association Mobility does <u>not</u> apply to ASET members with only C.E.T. or R.E.T. designation(s). A full application as an Engineering or Geoscience Licensee is required.</b></p>
<p><b><u>Pre April 2012</u></b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• R.P.T.(Eng.) and P.L. (Eng.) both existed</li> <li>• Both were APEGA Members – title and scope</li> <li>• Only NPPE or PPE accepted</li> <li>• APEGA confirmation of registration in good standing required by APEGS</li> <li>• APEGS reviews APEGA scope and may edit in keeping with APEGS format</li> <li>• <b>APEGS processes as Inter-Association Mobility applicant via the Registrar’s Acceptance List</b></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Title did not exist, there was R.E.T.or C.E.T. only</li> <li>• ASET nominated R.P.T.(Eng.)’s for Professional Licensee registration with APEGA</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ASET Members - title only</li> <li>• No formal approved scope</li> <li>• APEGS PPE or NPPE must be passed</li> <li>• <b>APEGS processes as a new applicant</b></li> </ul>
<p><b><u>Post April 2012</u></b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• APEGA Member – title and scope of practice set by APEGA</li> <li>• ASET membership not required</li> <li>• Title of all existing R.P.T.(Eng.)’s changed to P.L.(Eng.)and scope retained. There may be some grandfathered titles in circulation.</li> <li>• Only NPPE or PPE accepted</li> <li>• APEGA confirmation of registration in good standing required by APEGS</li> <li>• APEGS reviews APEGA scope and may edit in keeping with APEGS format</li> <li>• <b>APEGS processes as Inter-Association Mobility applicant via the Registrar’s Acceptance List</b></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New Designation under amended APEGA/ASET Act – replaces R.E.T.</li> <li>• Joint Board of Examiners approves the scope of practice</li> <li>• ASET had its own PPE prior to Jan 2014, APEGA will accept this exam, APEGS will accept it also</li> <li>• ASET confirmation of registration in good standing required by APEGS</li> <li>• APEGS uses the same scope approved by Joint Board of Examiners, including “routine application of industry recognized codes, standards, procedures, and practices using established engineering or applied science principles and methods of problem solving.”</li> <li>• <b>APEGS processes as Inter-Association Mobility applicant via the Registrar’s Acceptance List</b></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• RET title is grandfathered – no new R.E.T. titles granted after April 2012</li> <li>• Members holding an R.E.T. designation continue to be recognized in Alberta as senior-level practitioners of engineering technology or applied science technology</li> <li>• APEGS PPE or APEGA NPPE must be passed</li> <li>• <b>APEGS processes as a new applicant</b></li> </ul>
