

**IN THE MATTER OF THE ENGINEERING AND GEOSCIENCE PROFESSIONS ACT
AND IN THE MATTER OF INVESTIGATION RESPECTING
SADDAM HUSSAIN BASHASAB, ENGINEER-IN-TRAINING**

NOTICE OF DISCIPLINE HEARING

TAKE NOTICE that a panel of the Discipline Committee of The Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of Saskatchewan, constituted in accordance with the provisions of The Engineering and Geoscience Professions Act, will sit to hear and determine the formal complaints concerning the conduct of Saddam Hussain Bashasab, as a member of the Association.

The charges set out below are allegations referred to the Discipline Committee for hearing and have not yet been determined by the Discipline Committee. The particulars of the charges include:

Charge 1

Saddam Hussain Bashasab, Member-in-Training, demonstrated professional misconduct pursuant to section 30 of The Engineering and Geoscience Professions Act by acting in a manner which is harmful to the best interests of the public, tends to harm the standard of the profession, and/or which is a breach of ss 20(1) and/or 20(2)(e) of the Regulatory Bylaws, by preparing and submitting a validation in his Competency Assessment to APEGS which inaccurately identified Mike Rowe as the validator, without the knowledge, participation, or consent of Mr. Rowe.

Charge 2

Saddam Hussain Bashasab, Member-in-Training, demonstrated professional misconduct pursuant to section 30 of The Engineering and Geoscience Professions Act by acting in a manner which is harmful to the best interests of the public, tends to harm the standard of the profession, and/or which is a breach of ss 20(1) and/or 20(2)(e) of the Regulatory Bylaws, by providing dishonest and inaccurate information to the APEGS Registrar's Advisory Committee during its investigation.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the Discipline Committee hearing will be held on the 8th day of October 2026, commencing at 10:00 a.m. and scheduled to continue until 5:00 p.m.
