Organization Overview:

The Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency (SAMA) is an independent agency with responsibility to the Province of Saskatchewan, and local governments (municipalities). SAMA's mandate is to develop and maintain the province's property assessment policies, standards and procedures; audit property assessments, review and confirm municipal property assessment rolls; and provide property valuation services to local governments (municipalities).

SAMA is the recognized leader and authority on property assessment and is Saskatchewan's service provider of choice.

Position Overview:

SAMA requires a highly organized, motivated and results oriented oil and gas consultant to update the oil and gas resource production equipment (RPE), building and tank rates in the January 1, 2027 Saskatchewan Assessment Manual (Manual).

Reporting to the Technical Standards and Policy (TS&P) Division, the oil and gas consultant is a contract position (5 months – June 1, 2026 to October 30, 2026) with deliverables scheduled throughout 2026. The duties are to be performed as remote work within Saskatchewan.



Responsibilities:

Deliverables:

- Update the oil & gas RPE, building and tank assessment Manual rates to a January 1, 2027
 Base Date.
 - The components in need of updating are in chapters 3 & 4 of the Manual (SAMA will
 provide a precise listing).
- Provide 2027 vs 2023 Base Year shift analysis for oil & gas RPE, building and tank rates. SAMA
 will provide a spreadsheet with the 2023 base rates to facilitate the shift analysis.
 - o Include comments about the supply/demand factors that lead to rate shifts.
- Provide steel prices, journeyman/oilfield labour rates and a secondary containment rate as of the January 1, 2027 Base Date.
- Present a summary review of present and future economic climates regarding the oil and gas industry from a global, western Canadian and Saskatchewan perspective.
- Provide additional information to reasonable queries from SAMA regarding the deliverables (with respect to the research and analysis that were presented).

Throughout the contract period, SAMA will hold frequent orientation meetings with the consultant to explain the work, timelines and to provide clarification on the various issues.

Required Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in oil and gas or petroleum Engineering.
- Registered, or eligible for registration with APEGS: P. Eng. designation.
- Minimum 5 years of oil and gas industry experience.
- Other relevant degrees or certificates combined with oil and gas costing experience will also be considered.

- Technical knowledge of oil and gas RPE, buildings and tanks
- Extensive contacts within the oil & gas industry to obtain accurate costs as of Jan. 1, 2027
